



## Letter of Intent

Between

The Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research, Arab Republic of Egypt

and

Waseda University, Japan

for Partnership on Higher Education and Research Technology and

the Discussion of the Development of an International Campus Branch in Egypt

This Letter of Intent ( "LoI" ) is entered into by and between  
The Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research, Arab Republic of Egypt,  
located at 101 KasrAlaini St., Cairo, Egypt, represented by Prof. Dr. Khaled Abdel  
Ghaffar as Minister of Higher Education and Scientific Research,  
and

Waseda University, a higher education University in Japan and its principal office  
address at 1-104 Totsukamachi, Shinjuku-ku, Tokyo, Japan, represented by Prof. Seishi  
Sato as Vice President.

1. Both Parties have expressed their intent in making use of the existing partnership agreements between Waseda University and Egyptian universities which include:
  - (1) To encourage visits by faculty from one university to the other for the purpose of engaging in research or other educational activities;
  - (2) To facilitate the admission of qualified students from one university to the other for the purpose of enrolling in undergraduate and graduate programmes, and in the case of advanced graduate students, participating in research;
  - (3) To discuss the Development of an International Branch Campus (IBC) in Egypt;
  - (4) To foster the exchange of academic publications and scholarly information; and
  - (5) To promote other academic activities which enhance the above mentioned goals.
2. Both Parties shall enter into good faith negotiations for the above-mentioned activities after execution of the LoI.

3. This LoI is made in English and executed in duplicate with both parties retaining one copy.
